**Clinic Reminders** 

**Medication Pick-up/New Forms**: If you have medication(s) in the clinic, please <u>pick</u> <u>it/them up on the last day of school</u> (or before for "as needed"

medications). <u>Medication(s) must be picked-up by the parents, they cannot be sent home with the children</u>. Any remaining medication(s) <u>will be discarded</u> on the last day of school. When you pick-up your medication(s), new forms will be provided for the next school year.

**Health Forms**: Kindergarten - Completed Commonwealth of VA School Entrance Health Forms are being accepted for the upcoming school year.

<u>Rising 6<sup>th</sup> Graders</u>: If you have a rising 6<sup>th</sup> grader, remember to get the TDaP immunization and submit the official, signed immunization record from your medical provider, prior to the first day of school. If your child is not 11 years old and your physician wishes to defer the immunization until he/she is 11 years old, you **must** provide a medical exemption stating this from the physician. <u>All documentation must be</u> <u>submitted by the first day of school and strongly preferred by August 7, 2017</u>.

Please feel free to submit this required documentation at any time before the due dates!
