

Mentoring and Tutoring Program
Coming to Queen of Apostles This
Spring, Grades 4 - 8
Tuesday Evenings 6 pm - 8 pm

A new parish ministry is being offered at Queen of Apostles this Spring: an after school tutoring and mentoring program designed to help your child grow in virtue with a focus on improving his or her academic performance. The program will meet on Tuesday evenings from 6 to 8 p.m., through May 16 in the school. Weekly activities will include a virtue talk, a 15-minute one-on-one mentoring and goal setting session, and a study hall.

The program is open to youth currently in grades 4 through 8, and open to the school community as well as the parish and local community. It will be limited in enrollment to 30 students. # **Clinic Reminders**

**Medication Pick-up/New Forms**: If you have medication(s) in the clinic, please pick it/them up on the last day of school (or before for "as needed" medications). Medication(s) must be picked-up by the parents, they cannot be sent home with the children. Any remaining medication(s) will be discarded on the last day of school. When you pick-up your medication(s), new forms will be provided for the next school year.

**Health Forms: Kindergarten** - Completed Commonwealth of VA School Entrance Health Forms are being accepted for the upcoming school year.

**Rising 6th Graders**: If you have a rising 6th grader, remember to get the TDaP immunization and submit the official, signed immunization record from your medical provider, prior to the first day of school. If your child is not 11 years old and your physician wishes to defer the immunization until he/she is 11 years old, you must provide a medical exemption stating this from the physician. All documentation must be submitted by the first day of school and strongly preferred by August 7, 2017.

Please feel free to submit this required documentation at any time before the due dates!


