FAMILY SERVICE COMMITMENT

VIRTUS TRAINING FOR CHILD PROTECTION

Adults who volunteer at school activities are required to attend a VIRTUS seminar at a parish or school in the Diocese of Arlington to learn how to identify, report, and stop sexual abuse of children. This is a one-time requirement. The school office will receive notification that you have completed the seminar and background check. Adults who have not completed VIRTUS training will not be allowed to volunteer at events that involve significant interaction with children.
